Please note the times to arrive. This assures that we are as fair to everyone as we can possibly be. DO NOT COME EARLY!!!

- ✓ **IF YOU ARE PICKING UP FOOD FOR ANOTHER PERSON**, they must fill out a proxy pickup form for you to bring to registration. Details at the pantry or by calling (402) 522-6525
- ✓ All are welcomed.
- ✓ I.D. is for arrival time verification only.
- ✓ Food will be preboxed you do not need to bring boxes or baskets
- ✓ USDA income limits apply to some foods
- ✓ You will remain in your car. Follow volunteer instructions.
- ✓ Things change rapidly! Please be patient.

Your **LAST** name determines when you may come and drive through the food pantry.

THIS IS DETERMINED BY HOW YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE IS PRINTED.

The last name of the driver of the car is the only name used.

If your last name is hyphenated, it is the first last name (Smith-Jones is "S"). If you have more than one last name it is the last last name (Smith Valdez Jones is "J")

DO NOT ARRIVE EVEN ONE MINUTE EARLY. YOU WILL BE TURNED AWAY.

- Photo I.D. required for arrival time verification only.
- I.D.'s are checked at the parking entrance.
- One address = one household.
- If you carpool, arrival time is determined by the driver's identification.
- **Please do not park at Bethany Funeral Home, Ace Hardware or grass areas to wait.**
- La Vista Police and volunteers patrol the area.
- Those riding MOBY, walking, or with special circumstances will be dealt with case by case.
- There are no guarantees that we will not run out of items before everyone is served.
- **Please obey all traffic laws including no stopping in streets and no blocking of traffic lanes.**
- **PLEASE FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS OF VOLUNTEERS!** They are experienced and doing their best!

DISTRIBUTION FOR JAN. DUE TO COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS

- You will still come to receive food at specific times based on last names. See other side of this brochure for how last names are determined.
- Be prepared to show your identification through the window of your car.
- You will stay in your car always.
- Follow directions of volunteers for staying in the cue line.
- Registration, at car window, will be done because of USDA food provided.
- Volunteers will bring your pre-boxed food to your car. **DO NOT GET OUT OF THE CAR. OPEN TRUNKS FROM INSIDE FOR VOLUNTEERS TO PLACE FOOD IN THE TRUNK.**
